

Guide for Projects

- DEADLINE of the projects is **5 January 2006**. The deadline is **very STRICT!** Email me your executables/codes and submit hard copy of your reports **until 17:00**.
- Check the example projects on the course web site. You can select one of them or you can suggest your own project. In any case, you must clearly identify the requirements of the project and write them in your report.
- Grading of the projects is based on your reports and your program. Your programs will be graded according to its completeness, comprehensibility, consistency and aesthetic design. Also check the remarks for homeworks and projects on the course web site.
- You are required to show the “State Diagrams” for users actions in your project. You can do it by hand, or you can use some Software tools.
- You can use any programming language you want.
- Projects can also be done in groups. Group project topics must have a large scope (relatively larger than the single person projects) and increased functionality. If you have a group project, state clearly in your report the parts that each group member has done.
