T. Dutoit holds an electrical engineering (FPMs, 1988), and PhD degree (FPMs, 1993). He teaches Circuit Theory, Signal Processing, and Speech Processing at FPMs since 1993. Between 1996 and 1998, he spent 16 months at AT&T-Bell Labs, in Murray Hill (NJ) and Florham Park (NJ). He is the author of a reference book on speech synthesis (in English), and co-author of a book on speech processing (in French). He wrote or co-wrote about 60 papers on speech processing and software engineering. T. Dutoit has been an Associate Editor of the IEEE Transactions on Speech and Audio Processing (2003-2006) and is a member of the editorial board of Speech Communication. He is a member of the IEEE Signal Processing and Biomedical Engineering societies. He is the initiator of the eINTERFACE 4-weeks summer workshops on Multimodal Interfaces and was the organizer eINTERFACE05 in Mons, Belgium.
