## **MPI Installation Problems**

If you are using Windows and you have problems about MPI installation, the following information might be useful for you.

If your computer is 64-bit and you have installed 64-bit MPICH2 and if you have problems compiling the file in the examples folder, try removing the 64-bit version and download the 32-bit MPICH2. I have also tried OpenMP but I couldn't compile with OpenMP. Once you install 32-bit MPICH2 you may also download Eclipse for Parallel Application Developers. You should configure your project properties and include the header file and the library. If you are successful, you can also compile your codes using Eclipse after installing MPICH2.

If you have some Linux operating system, installing MPI might be easier.
